The West Bengal Board of Primary Education has received several representations from many self-financed D. El. Ed. institutions affiliated to this Board with a request to admit a considerable number of students who have not submitted their application forms for admission through online portal probably due to their late admission in those institutions (i.e. after the closing of the online admission portal of the Board). The issue of late admission was discussed in the Ad-hoc Committee Meeting held on 23/12/2022 under the agenda No. --07.

Pursuant to the resolution adopted in the said meeting, honorable President of the Board has kindly approved the appeal of those self-financed D. El. Ed. institutions to admit their non-enrolled students as a special case for this year only and strictly through online portal to be opened by the Board in the notified schedules. Furthermore, as per resolution of the Ad-hoc Committee, the West Bengal Board of Primary Education will not entertain any such request in future.
